

## Mark Nayman Reviews Marriott's Frenchman's Cove

Designed to reflect the Dutch and British influences on St. Thomas, Marriott's Frenchman's Cove will offer spacious, tasteful accommodations. Each two-bedroom, two-bath villa will have gracious living and dining areas, its own fully equipped kitchen, multiple televisions, a DVD player, and laundry facilities. Vacationers can savor the relaxing Caribbean spirit and relish extraordinary views of the water and the rich, green landscape from private balconies.

Marriott's Frenchman's Cove is tucked along a picturesque hillside overlooking the calm azure waters of Pacquereau Bay, Marriott's Frenchman's Cove will be a breathtaking complement to the beauty of St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands. Adjacent to Frenchman's Reef & Morning Star Marriott Beach Resort this spacious resort will be reminiscent of a quaint village surrounded by a secluded beach with amazing views of the Bay and St. Thomas harbor. Like the nearby historic town of Charlotte Amalie, the overall design reflects the Danish and British architectural influences set amidst a colorful tropical landscape.

The Cove has a pretty fabulous location – 13.3 acres, with its own secluded beach next to the Marriott Frenchman's Reef and Morning Star beach resort (6 miles SE of the airport). It has amazing views of the Pacquereau Bay and the St. Thomas harbor, and the Reef is on its own bluff overlooking Morningstar beach.

The Cove has its own beach which is pretty nice, but not quite as pretty as the one next door at the Reef (Morning Star Beach, which is also available to Cove guests, and actually everyone, as all the beaches on the island are public). The Cove's beach has watersports rentals, etc. Morningstar is a beautiful beach; quiet; has plenty of chairs and umbrellas, and beach hut which has towels and rents floats and boogie boards, and snorkel gear. The snorkeling is good if you go all the way down to the left end of the beach, by the rocks.

The resort has activities each day such as scavenger hunt, float races, ping pong, live island music, iguana feeding (they're all over the resort), tug-of-war, sand castle contests, etc.
